

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY POLICY

INTRODUCTION

The earth's environment is under severe stress from uncontrolled human activity, threatening the performance of Binthi Land Holding Group Aboriginal Corporation's [BLHGAC's] mission and the survival of our society.

[BLHGAC] accepts that it must work to preserve the environmental sustainability of the planet, at all levels of its operations — in its own practice, as a participant in a community of practice, and as a participant in the Australian social discourse.

[BLHGAC] aspires to minimise its impact on our environment and maximise the effective use of resources. We strive to achieve this by increasing awareness and communication of our efforts in accordance with this policy and fostering responsible environmental behaviour amongst staff, users at all levels and volunteers.

[BLHGAC] is committed not only to complying with applicable law in all of its operations but to minimise impacts and risks through the development of documented and robust systems to disseminate, implement, measure, and monitor excellent environmental performance both to the broader community and within its operations.

PURPOSE

This Environmental Sustainability Policy aims to integrate a philosophy of sustainable development into all the organisation's activities and to establish and promote sound environmental practice in our operations.

POLICY

[BLHGAC] commits itself to minimising its impact on our environment through:

- Being an environmentally responsible neighbour in our community;
- Conducting evaluations, rigorous audits, and self-assessments of the implementation of this policy;
- Conserving natural resources by recycling and reusing;
- Enhancing awareness among our employees, volunteers, and users educating and motivating them to act in an environmentally responsible manner;
- Ensuring the responsible use of energy throughout the organisation;
- Having an environmentally sustainable aware culture, where responsibility is assigned and understood;
- Participating in efforts to improve environmental protection and understanding;
- Providing a healthful and safe workplace;
- Taking steps to improve environmental performance continually;
- Using, in our own operations, processes that do not adversely affect the environment; and
- Working with suppliers who promote sound environmental practices.
